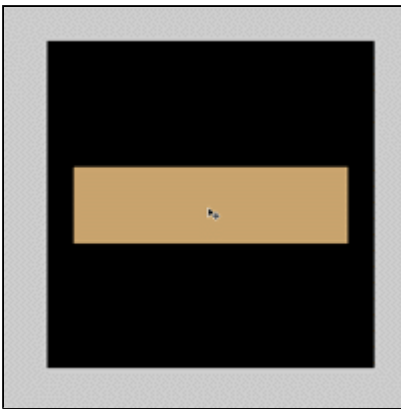


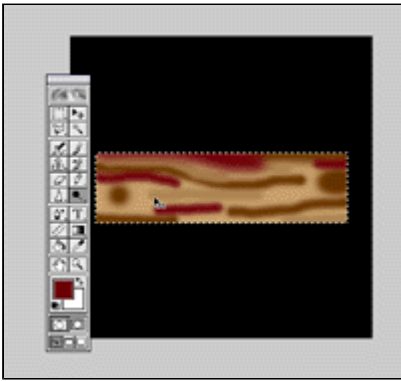
Create a Wood Panel Pattern Texture Effect

1



Make a rectangle of whatever size you prefer. Fill the shape with a light brown color.

2



With the airbrush, use darker shades and randomly make lines and dots that look like wood grain and knots.

After you have achieved the desired texture, take the **Burn** and **Dodge** tools to lighten and darken various areas of the rectangle.

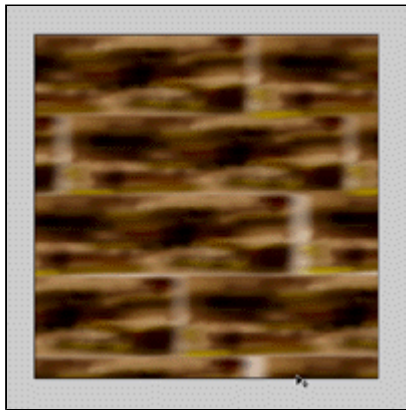

Choose **Select All** and apply a motion blur of 15-20 pixels. Repeat with the **Dodge** and **Burn** tool

Finally use the **Smudge** tool to create variations in the wood grain. Choose **Select All**, then copy and paste the pattern you created into a larger document. Make sure to paste the panels in a random order, stacking them on top of each other when needed. Crop and stretch until you get a look that you like.

Flatten the image, then use the **Burn** tool on the edges near the panel connections to give it more contrast.
